To the leaders of the African Union:

A fascist plot is unfolding upon the Great Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya. Testimony by United States Congressman Dennis Kucinich made clear that the insurrection in Libya is a CIA instigated and directed armed attempt to overthrow the government of Libya. Traditional diplomacy is impossible because the foreign aggressors' plan is the complete overthrow of the Libyan state. An understanding of the financial causes of the aggression is needed and a revolutionary and nonviolent plan by sovereign African states must be urgently considered to end it.

Brother Leader of the Revolution Muammar Al Gaddafi has presented a sound money proposal to adopt a gold based unified African currency for use in the international settlement of trade. It is clear that his plan to introduce a new Gold Dinar and demand payment for Libya's oil using it threatened the dollar denominated international financial system and was the prompting cause for the current aggression.

The importance and benefits of sound money backed by gold has a long history and has many advocates, including United States presidential candidate Ron Paul. Implementing such a plan today by any good number of the natural resource exporting states of the African Union presents the possibility of an almost immediate cessation of hostilities in Libya and will not only increase their rightful wealth but enhance the prospects for sustained regional peace and security. If Africa takes the lead it is believed that other states will soon follow including India, China and Iran.

Libya is blessed that its fellow states of Africa continue to stand united against the aggression in support of the good people of the sovereign Great Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya. This urgent plea asks the leaders of the African Union to convene an emergency session to consider, adopt and implement the brother leader of the revolution's sound money proposal. Successfully challenging the money power of the Federal Reserve and western central banks created by their system of fiat currencies without intrinsic value can not only end the crusader colonial aggression against Libya but also the many wars it is waging throughout the world.

Dear honorable President Zuma,

I humbly submit myself before you without pretense and with honorable purposes addressing you through Ms. Shannon Samee (samees@dirco.gov.za) with your good offices at the South African Embassy in Washington D. C.. Attached you will find for your review a document titled "Urgent Plea to all Sovereign African Nations" with a heading containing the member nations of the African Union and the names of their leaders.

The document is short and intended to speak for itself. It is now abundantly clear that no settlement even temporarily ceasing the hostilities against Libya was ever or will ever be allowed. Even dialog has been refused by the US/NATO supported CIA operation in Bengazi because, clearly, the insurgent force has nobody credible to put forward. The possibility of meaningful dialogue is, therefore, nonexistent.

Understanding the above and that the destruction and killing are continuing and increasing, the plea is for the member states of the African Union to take a rational, measured and meaningful step forward in their own self interest and the interests of the sovereign Libyan state.

I beg that you distribute the document to the honorable members of the African Union whose names appear in the header and that you do further urge that an emergency meeting be convened to consider, adopt and implement the plan to adopt a common Gold based currency (Sound Money) for the settlement of international transactions.
